Reference:

Read Luke 12:1-7 and open in prayer.

Review:

What was one thing from this weekend's message or scripture reference that stood out to you?

Reflect:

1. Share a lighthearted example of when you had a secret that was accidentally exposed, or when something that was meant to be kept from someone else was found out.
2. In Luke 12:2, Jesus says that all things will be exposed. Is this comforting or stressful to you? Why? Which *should* it be: comforting or stressful?
3. Why is the doctrine of hell so difficult for many people to believe? (Luke 12:5)
4. What does it mean to fear God? What are some examples of what this looks like? (Luke 12:5)
5. Luke 12:58-59 is the summary application for this entire chapter. How do we "be reconciled" before we face the judge? What does that passage mean?
6. What is the benefit to dealing with sin today instead of keeping it hidden until judgment day? How can you practically do that?
