



Week 2: Seek God for Yourself

Senior High

1. What is something you have been curious about lately, serious or not? What made you want to know more?
2. Ecclesiastes 3:11 says God has placed eternity in our hearts, yet we cannot understand everything He is doing. Why do you think we want answers so badly?
3. What usually happens when you have a question that does not have an easy answer? Do you keep looking, ask someone, forget about it, or something else?
4. In Matthew 7:7-11, Jesus tells people to ask, seek, and knock. What does that tell you about how God wants us to approach questions about Him?
5. What is one question about God, Scripture, faith, or life that you think is actually worth pursuing right now?

Junior High

1. What is something random you have wondered about recently?
2. Why do you think some questions are fun to investigate while others are easier to ignore?
3. Ecclesiastes says we will not understand everything God is doing. How can you still follow God when you do not understand everything?
4. Jesus says to ask, seek, and knock. What are some ways you could actually seek an answer to a question about God or faith?
5. What is one question you would like to spend some time looking into instead of just wondering about it?

Practice: Chase a Question

Have each student write down one question they genuinely want to know more about. It can be something random, something about life, or something about God or Scripture.

Then have them decide on one way they will investigate it this week. They do not need to solve the question this week. The goal is simply to practice seeking instead of shrugging.
