- 3. In verse 39, Philip was snatched away by the Spirit. Maybe you've never suddenly appeared in a new place but have you ever been surprised by what God orchestrated in your life?

- 4. What is it about the idea of God sending us out to do good things in His name that can make us uncomfortable, hesitant or fearful?

 5. When are we most likely to fall into the trap of seeking God's
- blessings without answering the sending call to be a blessing?

- 7. How do you know what good works God planned in advance for you to do?
