## SINGLE MOM'S DAY

Picture this—a single mom pulls into the parking lot, unsure of what to expect. She's tired—of juggling schedules, of stretching resources, of carrying more than her share. But she's greeted with a smile, her car is taken care of, and for the first time in a while, she's told, "Today is for you." That's the heart of **Single Mom's Day**.

Each year, we create a space where single moms in Mayes County are not just served, but celebrated. Valets welcome them and take their cars to a local mechanic for a complimentary oil change. Their kids are cared for in a fun, safe environment and even receive haircuts—while mom steps into a peaceful, un-rushed space designed just for her.

She's invited to rest. To soak her feet. To enjoy a chair massage or a manicure. To browse a book and bath shop. To sit quietly, breathe deeply, and feel seen. Along the way, gentle moments of prayer and ministry are offered—not forced, but freely given—reminders that she is not alone and that God sees her story.

Our hope is simple: that each mom leaves knowing she is deeply valued and unconditionally loved. No strings attached. Just the love of Jesus, expressed through Jesus' people, showing up with compassion, dignity, and joy.

And this is where you come in.

There are so many ways to help make this day possible—donating items, serving on the day of the event, or helping create the calm, welcoming environment that makes Single Mom's Day so meaningful. A FRONT-ROW SEAT TO GOD'S WORK - BY MATT MARTIN (2025 COUNCIL PRESIDENT)






