Junior High

2. What is the difference between living with God's purpose and being driven by other people's pressure?
3. What is most likely to pull your attention away from Jesus this school year?
4. Read John 15:4–5. What could remaining connected to Jesus look like during an ordinary school week?
5. What is one realistic practice you could begin this week, and how could this group help you continue it?
