




What if the joy you've been looking for is outside your comfort zone?

The arrival of Jesus wasn't wrapped in comfort—it was wrapped in courage and costly obedience. This Advent, we'll follow the stories of those who first received the news: a doubting priest, a startled girl, a conflicted fiancé, and a series of astounded witnesses. Each had to step outside their comfort zones to experience the joy God had prepared. Could it be that the peace & joy we long for at Christmas is most deeply discovered in our willingness to say yes to God, even when it's uncomfortable?

Each Sunday in December holds moments you don't want to miss. From children's choirs and nativities, to advent candles, to communion, let worship shape your Christmas this year!







These days, the word advent is synonymous with Christmas. Advent calendars—featuring everything from chocolate to Legos to whiskey—fill store shelves to count us down to a day of celebration and gift-giving. Few stop to consider what this now-seasonal word actually means

Advent literally means "to come." Before Christ, the term heralded the arrival of emperors. But after Jesus ascended to heaven, it became connected to His promised second coming. It wasn't until the 6th century that the word advent became associated with Christ's nativity. Since then, Christians have held these two ideas together: Christ came—and He is coming again.

By the way, that's why it's so fitting that our Bible reading plans take us through the book of Revelation in December. And this is a great time to make a plan for engaging Scripture in 2026. Check this column monthly for more details!

In more recent centuries, Christians began marking Advent with the lighting of candles and the themes of hope, peace, joy, and love. Here's what you can expect at Creekside this year:

November 30 - Hope

We will light the first candle of Advent, remembering the hope with which the world awaited Christ's first coming—and stirring our own hearts to long for His return.

DECEMBER 7 - PEACE

We will light the second candle, remembering the peace Christ brought to our hearts in His first coming, and the peace He will bring to the world when He comes again.

DECEMBER 14 - JOY

We will light the third candle, remembering the joy of shepherds and angels, even as we rejoice in all He has done and all He has promised to do.

DECEMBER 21 – LOVE

We will light the fourth candle, marking Love—for love entered the world on that first Christmas morning, fills our hearts by His Spirit, and will be the law that governs Creation when He comes again.

CHRISTMAS EVE - CHRIST

And last but not least, we will gather to light the Christ candle. Christ was born into our world. May He be born anew in our hearts, so that He will find us ready when He returns.
