suggested discussion questions

getting connected with scripture:

- In what ways might it have been easier for people in Jesus' day to maintain a habit of weekly worship with a community of believers than it is now?
 - In what ways might it have been harder for them than for us?
- The people Jesus & Paul gathered with did not often share compatible beliefs and were often even antagonistic toward them.
 - Why do you think they persisted in joining these worship gatherings?
 - What can we learn from their example to be applied in our context?

getting real with each other:

- Gathering for worship has arguably never been more convenient than it is for us.
 - What do you believe are some of the reasons that fewer and fewer sincere believers commit to weekly worship gatherings?
 - Which reasons stand out as the greatest challenge for you, personally?
 - What do you imagine Jesus or Paul might say to us in response to these reasons?
- **Reflection Question:** Who would the Lord have you pray for or even speak with, that they might place greater priority on weekly worship gatherings?

getting practical with our faith:

- How would you describe the value or benefits of weekly worship gatherings?
- What can we do to add value to the experience of those who gather with us?
