In April of this year, a group of Creeksiders attended a spiritual retreat at Spring Valley Ranch. In a beautiful and quiet setting, free from worries about meals or schedules, we spent intentional time in prayer and reflection. In solitude, we asked the Holy Spirit to help us process our recent past and grow in intentionality for the future.

Here's some of the feedback from that day:

More than one participant had been walking through recent difficulties and shared that the day of reflection was deeply helpful in processing past trauma and clarifying future goals.

One attendee described it as “a wonderful day of quiet, scheduled times together as a group, and then lots of individual time for Bible reading, prayer, or simply sitting in God’s creation.” They added, “I’m hoping that through the process I learned, and that I’m more committed to allowing Jesus to help me follow more closely after Him!”

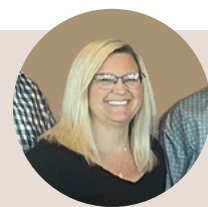
Another person shared, “It was the first time in well over 30 years that I had been on a retreat, and it was perfect! I loved every minute! 🙌”

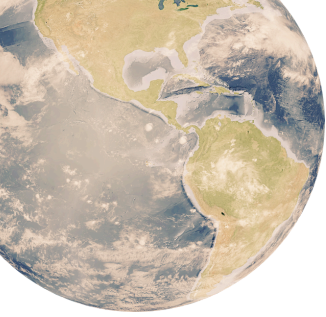

I wanted to share an update about one of our local outreach ministries through the Care Team. This ministry is dedicated to helping families in our community who are facing unexpected financial hardships. Some of these needs include utility bills, auto repairs, medical expenses, and fuel costs. Through this ministry, we have the opportunity to share God’s love in a practical and meaningful way with those around us. In 2025, the Care Team was able to help ease the burden for nearly 70 families in the Pryor area. So far in 2026, we have already been able to bless approximately 25 families. None of this would be possible without your continued generosity and faithful support. You may be wondering how this ministry works. Families in need can visit the church office and complete a request form explaining their situation. Our Care Team then reviews each request carefully and prays over every need. The team works diligently each month to help meet as many needs as possible, whether through financial assistance or by connecting families with helpful local resources. What a blessing it is to serve our community in this way. At Creekside, sharing the love of Christ continues to be at the heart of all we do. How can you be part of this ministry? Pray for the members of the Care Team as they serve and make decisions, pray for the families who are experiencing hardship, and continue being the generous and compassionate church family that makes this ministry possible.
