There was false teaching in Ephesus



1 Tim 1:3-7

"3As I urged you when I was going to Macedonia, remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, 4nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith. [...] ⁶Certain persons, by swerving from these, have wandered into vain discussion, desiring to be teachers of the law, without understanding either what they are saying or the things about which they make confident assertions."

2 Tim 2:16–18

"Avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness, and their talk will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaus and Phileus, who have swerved from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already happened. They are upsetting the faith of some."

- 2. Beware of continuous questioning (2 Tim 3:7)

- 4. Humility




