Colossians 2:16-19

Background: Colossians 2:8-23 is in the section of the book dealing with “The Heresy of Christ + Something Else: Rejecting Spiritual Add-ons.”

Tension: What if we are doing the same thing in regard to Jesus?

Six simple ways to shipwreck your spiritual life:

1. Submit to the final authority of someone other than Jesus. (v 16a)
2. Decide that you are spiritually sanctified by what you do or don’t eat and drink. (v 16b)
3. Decide that the timing of spiritual activity sanctifies or defiles you. (v 16c)
4. Decide that self-abasement pleases God. (v 18a)
5. Decide that worshiping anyone/anything besides God or in addition to God is good. (v 18b)
6. Decide that visions or revelation outside the Bible are true and necessary. (v 18c)

Two simple ways to catalyze your spiritual life:

1. Be clear that Jesus Christ is the substance and all else is only shadow. (v 17)
2. Hold fast to Jesus Who is the Head of the church, therefore the Head of each one of us. (v 19)

Core Idea of Colossians 2:16-19: Jesus alone is the Substance...and real life is found in Him. Period.

This reminds me of something I heard somewhere: “We exist to glorify God by pointing the affections of all peoples to the all-satisfying Person of Jesus Christ.”

And: “I am the Way and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” Jn 14:6

7. Imitate Him all the time. 1 Corinthians 11:1
8. Share Him with anyone you can. Matthew 4:19
9. With everyone, graciously and naturally “raise the flag” as a Christ-follower.
Acts 4:14, 14
10. Keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Col 3:1
