"There is no indication that Luke and Matthew are dependent on Greco-Roman or oriental birth stories as their source. To the contrary, the birth narratives are saturated with Old Testament themes and possess a distinctive Jewish character ... not only that, other mythic birth stories like that of Augustus imply some human-divine sexual union that is entirely absent from the Gospel accounts ... If the gospel writers are trying to borrow from the mythological stories they didn't do a very good job because they don't include any of the specifically mythological elements that are in those stories."
