## Acts 17:11

"These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so." (NKJV)

"They found that the Jews of Berea were of more noble character and much more open minded than those of Thessalonica. They were hungry to learn and eagerly received the word. Every day they opened the scrolls of Scripture to search and examine them, to verify that what Paul taught them was true." (TPT)

When we come together for a time when the Word is Yahweh is released, do we find ourselves ready to receive with an open mind and eager to the point of spiritually hungry to receive the Word?
