

Rehearsing the Word

Overall Theme:

Repentance is less an emotional response and more so a changing of perspective. The major emphasis of the last two Sunday's messages have revolved around the number nine (9). Autumn and I entered a "season" of repentance, which led to re-membering (realigning) and re-minding (thinking on things above with the mind of Christ) the ecclesia and our personal lives toward the ultimate intention of Yahshua the Christ to build His kingdom in the earth as it already exists in the heavens. This building project is trans-generational and must not be judged on how it feels in the present only but also how it affects the future as well. A wise master builder builds from the past (inheritance), in the present (grace) and for the future (consummate kingdom). There is a future glory that can only be seen by the Spirit and engaged by faith to become a reality.

Scriptures:

- Acts 2:36-39 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." 37 Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" 38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."
- 1 Corinthians 3:10 Through Yahshua's grace, we are all being equipped to be wise master builders as Yahshua's kingdom is being built in the earth as it already exists in the heavens.
- **Philippians 3:12-16** To grasp the enormity of Christ's kingdom, Paul had to let go of his past achievements, views and mindsets and accept the upward call of Christ personally and join himself to others corporately who shared the same mind of Christ.
- Romans 12:1-2 Paul entreats the Romans to not settle for the good or the acceptable, but allow the Spirit to transform and renew one's mind to the bigger picture and wider context of kingdom expression rather than personal satisfaction.
- Matthew 27:62-66 Many people have allowed their need for security to position them in a secure tomb, sealed with a stone and guarded. Yahshua has "subdued" or placed and positioned each member of His body for the divine outcome and not one of us has been assigned to an empty tomb.

Key Word & Quotes:

- The kingdom is dimensional and progressional.
- Repentance is changing our view and perspective in agreement with the mind of Christ.
- Yahweh will pause the mission to redeem your identity in Christ.
- Seven (7) Yahweh has sworn an oath and will fulfill and complete His intention.

- Nine (9) is a number that represents judgement and finality. These are necessary to move forward to ten (perfection of order) and twelve (perfection of kingdom government)
- Vocation the ultimate intention and redemption of the original creation.
- Re-membering and Re-minding

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How long have you been in your current dimension of kingdom expression? Are you still experiencing the grace (divine empowerment), joy and passion for the current dimension you are expressing?
- 2. Describe your faith vision right now for your immediate future. Does it help Yahshua build His kingdom on earth?
- 3. Are the people you feel joined and jointed to right now of the same mind of Christ or are you satisfied with being a loner or surrounded with people who don't challenge the Christ within you?
- 4. Are you willing to see beyond the veil and judge your current position to transcend the lines that have held you in place for lanes that will transport you to partner with Yahshua the Christ?
- 5. Does the Christ anointing reverberate from within you like concentric circles of a rock splashed in a pond? How far does the Christ in you extend?
- 6. Are you actively putting a Word on the other side of your life or are you satisfied with where you are currently. Pre-cross or post-resurrection.
- 7. What does it mean practically for you to be seated with Christ in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6) and to "seek" those things "above" where Christ is, while also "setting" your mind on things "above" (Colossians 3:1-4). Would you consider yourself more mindful of the things of the world than the things of Yahweh? (Matthew 16:23)

CHILDREN: Discuss with your children the temptation to identify with the adamic nature of self-awareness and become tuned to the nature of Christ which focuses on how to connect Yahweh's heaven to the earth in which they live. Continue to discuss how your children hear Yahweh's voice and interpret what they hear into the bigger picture and purpose of Christ's kingdom.

Father, I am personally thankful for Your patience and longsuffering with Your creation of mankind. However, through Holy Spirit, I desire to continue to move forward in Christ and not allow myself to be tempted to be safe and secure in a forsaken tomb of religion.
