**Key text:** Romans 2:1-7, 11, 19-23

**Suppl. texts:** Heb. 4:13, 1 Sam. 16:7b, Prov. 16:2, Matt. 7:1-4

**Introduction:** Today, let's understand the judgment of God.

1. Moral judgments with flawed knowledge (vs. 1-7)

- They **assumed** Rom. 1:18-32 applied to **Gentiles**.
- More **accountable** & more **responsible**.
- The religious **actor**, who wears a mask.
- The religious **moralist**, who doesn't struggle.
- The religious **legalist**, who is self-assured.
- **Blame**, pointing the finger w/o **perceiving**.
- **Brazen**, so brash to forget your life is **observed**.
- **Bite**, so full of bitterness you only see **badness**.
- **Blind**, dismissing **seriousness** & consequences.

## 2. The *perfect* & *righteous* judgment of God (vs. 11)

- Says much about the character of God.
- He sees all people the same, just as they are.
- Only God's judgment is perfect.
- We won't be able to argue our opinion.

### 3. Warning against hypocrisy (vs. 19-23)

- Hardening of the arteries leads to physical death.
- Hardening of the heart leads to spiritual death.
- Matt. 7:1-4 is not a blanket prohibition, but how to use proper judgment. Judging with humility.
- Have you bet everything?
