 A song (psalm) for worship (vs. 1-5) The outflow & overflow of the Christian heart. Overwhelmed by what God has done. 'Todah'; a voluntary sacrifice of pure thanks. Resounding praise to the Lord. Have you ever marveled? Characteristics of thankful people (vs. 6-11) Shallow roots that last only for a season. God's eternality is revealed. Nothing can overcome. No enemy can stand. Giving thanks, even in the worst times. Continuously giving thanks. God is our strength. His victory is our victory. The roots of a thankful life (vs. 12-15) Deeply rooted like trees. 	
 A <u>fruitful</u> tree. A <u>valuable</u> tree. Both are <u>tough</u> & <u>endure</u> harshness. Productive saints who don't spiritually <u>retire</u>.
