## 2. Characteristics of thankful people (vs. 6-11)

- Giving thanks, even in the worst times.
- Continuously giving thanks.
- God is our strength.
- His victory is our victory.

### 3. The roots of a thankful life (vs. 12-15)

- **Deeply rooted** like trees.
- A **fruitful** tree. A **valuable** tree.
- Both are **tough** & **endure** harshness.
- **Productive** saints who don't spiritually **retire**.
- Therefore, we are not **complainers**.
