Key text: Romans 10:1-4, 9-17, 21

Suppl. texts: Eph. 2:8-9, Is. 52:7, Nahum 1:15a, Is. 53:1

Introduction: Today, we'll see Israel's present continued rejection, moving from sovereignty to human responsibility.

1. The enormity of our sin debt (vs. 1-4)

- A **nationalistic rejection** remains.
- God never accepts based on personal **performance**.
- By **grace** alone, through **faith** alone, in **Christ** alone.
- God will not be **indebted** to anyone's **efforts**.
- *What is our responsibility?*

2. The way of salvation (vs. 9-13)

- Jesus is **Yahweh**! Jesus is Lord!
- An early **confession** of faith in the N.T. Church?
- There is no salvation without Christ's **Lordship**!

3. The remedy for anyone's rejection (vs. 14-17, 21)

- A missional text.
- A preacher must be called & readied.
- Israel's current need for redemption.
- A messenger must be sent.
- The remedy for Israel, or for any lost person.
- The great Messianic chapter of the O.T.
- A willing vessel, an instrument to be used in the hands of the Master Musician.
