2. **Dying** so that we can **live**! (vs. 11-14)

- Moved from indicative to imperative.
- A certain, definite understanding of a settled fact.
- Sin wants to be the sovereign ruler over your life.
- A transfer of obedience has occurred.
- A military command.
- Rules of conduct & discipline. Willfully submitted.
- At Christ's disposal & command.

3. Wages or a gift? (vs. 23)

- Non-believers are **earning** all the time.
- **Storing** up the wages of sin.
- Believers don't earn **anything** by their 'goodness'.
- We are **shielded** from death & its wages.
