

# HANDOUT — Hosanna: Save Now, Not Later

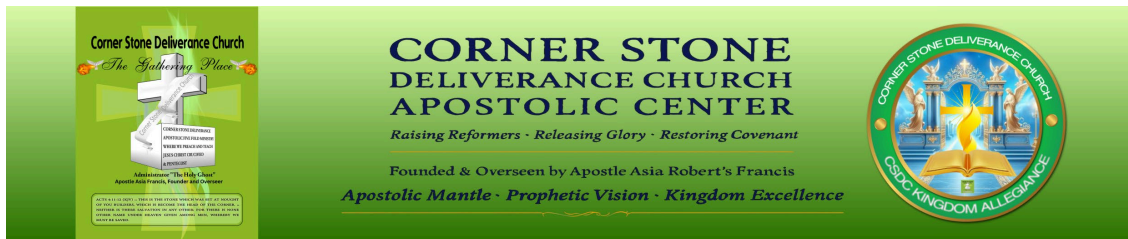
**Speaker:** Apostle Asia Francis **Scripture Focus:** *Psalm 118:25 – 26; Matthew 21:9; Luke 19:38–44*

## Theme

The cry of *Hosanna* is not a song of celebration alone — it is a **prophetic summons** for divine intervention. It means “*Save now, Lord!*” and carries the urgency of Heaven’s timing.

## Key Points

1. **Hosanna is a decree, not a delay.** It demands salvation, healing, and deliverance in the present moment.
2. **The King responds to the cry of now.** Jesus entered Jerusalem as the fulfillment of prophecy — salvation manifested.
3. **Delay is disobedience when Heaven is moving now.** The Spirit calls believers to act, obey, and align immediately.
4. **The cry of Hosanna activates divine movement.** When faith speaks “now,” Heaven releases miracles, healing, and breakthrough.
5. **Salvation is not postponed — it is present.** The Kingdom operates in the *now* of God’s timing, not human hesitation.

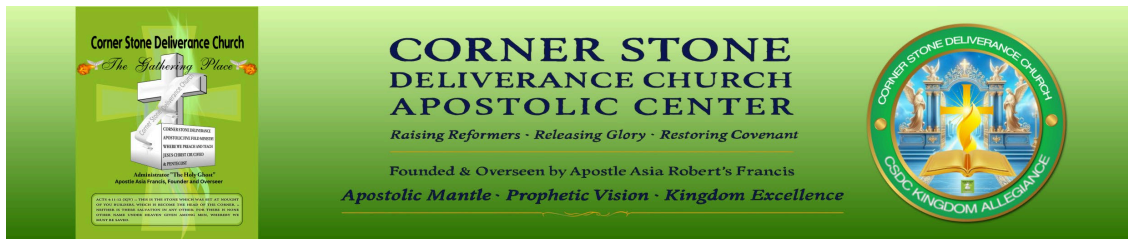


## Reflection
