“Behold, He Comes Quickly And Everything Shifts”

Apostle Asia Roberts-Francis Revelation 22:12 — “And behold, I come quickly; and My reward is with Me...”

1. SERMON OVERVIEW

This message awakens the believer to the urgency of Christ’s movement in this hour. “Quickly” does not speak to human time but divine intervention, God stepping into *chronos* with *kairos* acceleration. The King is not delayed; He is deliberate. His coming is sudden, purposeful, and reward-bearing.

This teaching calls the remnant to readiness, purity, and alignment as we anticipate His appearing and His activity.

2. KEY THEMES

A. The Immediacy of Christ’s Movement

- “Quickly” = suddenly, without warning
- God’s timing is perfect, not postponed
- His return and His interventions are imminent

B. Chronos vs. Kairos

- **Chronos** — human time, measured, predictable
- **Kairos** — divine interruption, appointed moment
- God rewards those who discern the shift

C. The Call to Readiness


- Spiritual vigilance



DAY 1 — The King Is Not Delayed

Scripture: Revelation 22:12 **Focus:** God’s timing is perfect. His movement is intentional. **Prayer:** “Lord, align my heart with Your timing.”

DAY 2 — Living Watchful

Scripture: Matthew 24:42 **Focus:** Watchfulness is a posture of the spirit, not the eyes. **Prayer:** “Awaken me from every place of spiritual slumber.”

DAY 3 — Strength for Faithfulness

Scripture: Hebrews 10:35–36 **Focus:** Endurance positions you for reward. **Prayer:** “Give me grace to remain steadfast.”

DAY 4 — Kairos Moments


Scripture: Ecclesiastes 3:1 **Focus:** God steps into time with divine purpose. **Prayer:** “Help me discern Your appointed moments.”

DAY 5 — Purity & Readiness

Scripture: 1 John 3:2–3 **Focus:** Purity prepares the vessel for His appearing. **Prayer:** “Purify my motives, thoughts, and desires.”

DAY 6 — Stewarding Your Assignment






