“Jesus Is the Balm”

1. SERMON OVERVIEW

This message reveals the powerful truth that **Jesus is the Balm**—the divine remedy for every wounded place in the human soul, spirit, and body. Drawing from the prophetic cry of Jeremiah and the healing ministry of Jesus, Apostle Eartha Wright Morgan declares that the Balm is not a location but a **Person**, and His name is **Jesus Christ**.

Where Jesus is present, **healing flows**, restoration manifests, and brokenness is made whole.

2. KEY SCRIPTURES

Jeremiah 8:18–22


The prophet laments the condition of God’s people and asks, *“Is there no balm in Gilead?”* This question points forward to Christ—the true Balm sent from Heaven.

Jeremiah 46:11

Human remedies fail, but God’s remedy—Christ—never fails.

1 Peter 2:24

Jesus bore our sins in His own body on the tree. **By His stripes we were healed.**



3. HEALING ENCOUNTERS OF JESUS

Blind Bartimaeus (Mark 10:46–52)

- He cried out despite opposition
- Jesus stopped for him
- His sight was restored
- Faith activated the miracle

Peter's Mother-in-Law (Mark 1:29–31)

- Jesus touched her hand
- Fever left immediately
- She rose and served
- Healing produced restoration and purpose

These encounters reveal the same truth: **When Jesus shows up, healing manifests.**

4. THEMES OF THE MESSAGE


Jesus Is the Balm

- He heals the brokenhearted
- He restores the wounded
- He delivers the oppressed
- He mends what no earthly remedy can reach

Healing Is Part of the Finished Work

- Christ carried our sickness
- Christ carried our sin
- Christ carried our sorrow
- Healing is not a hope, it is a covenant promise

The Balm Still Works Today

Whether the wound is:

- Emotional
- Spiritual
- Physical
- Generational

Jesus remains the remedy Heaven has provided.

5. FAITH ACTIVATION POINTS

- Cry out to Jesus like Bartimaeus
- Receive His touch like Peter's mother-in-law
- Believe the Word above the wound
- Expect immediate and progressive healing
- Stand on the finished work of the cross

6. DECLARATIONS OF HEALING


Speak these aloud:

- **Jesus is my Balm, and He heals me completely.**
- **By His stripes, I am healed.**
- **Every broken place in me is being restored by Christ.**
- **The healing virtue of Jesus flows through my body, mind, and spirit.**
- **I receive the Balm of Gilead, Jesus Himself.**

7. REFLECTION QUESTIONS


1. What area of your life needs the touch of the Balm?

4. What step of faith is God calling you to take today?

8. PRAYER

Lord Jesus, You are the Balm sent from Heaven. Touch every wounded place in me. Heal my body, restore my soul, and strengthen my spirit. Let Your healing virtue flow through every part of my life. I receive the finished work of the cross, and I declare that by Your stripes, I am healed. Amen.



7-DAY DEVOTIONAL

DAY 1 — *The Balm Revealed*

Scripture: *Jeremiah 8:22* “Is there no balm in Gilead?” The prophet’s cry points to a future answer—Jesus Himself.

Reflection

Many seek healing in places, people, or practices, but true healing is found in a Person. Jesus is Heaven’s remedy for every wound. Today, allow your heart to acknowledge that the Balm is not distant—He is present.

Affirmation

Jesus is my Balm, and He heals the places nothing else can reach.

Prayer

Lord Jesus, reveal Yourself as the Balm in every area of my life. Heal what I cannot articulate and restore what I cannot fix. Amen.

Call to Action

Write down one area where you need the healing touch of Jesus.


DAY 2 — *The Balm That Never Fails*

Scripture: *Jeremiah 46:11* Earthly remedies fail, but the divine remedy—Christ—never fails.

Reflection

Some wounds linger because we’ve applied the wrong treatment. God invites you to stop returning to broken cisterns and to receive the healing that only Christ can give.

Affirmation

I turn from temporary remedies and receive the eternal healing of Christ.

Prayer

Father, forgive me for trusting in lesser remedies. I receive the healing that comes only from Jesus. Amen.

Call to Action

Release one coping mechanism or habit that has not brought true healing.

DAY 3 — *By His Stripes, I Am Healed*

Scripture: *1 Peter 2:24* “By His stripes you were healed.”

Reflection

Healing is not a future hope—it is a finished work. Jesus carried your sickness, sorrow, and sin. Healing is not earned; it is received.

Affirmation

Healing belongs to me because of the finished work of Jesus.

Prayer

Lord, help me to believe Your Word above my symptoms, emotions, and circumstances. Amen.


Call to Action

Declare this Scripture aloud three times today.

DAY 4 — *The Cry That Stops Jesus*

Scripture: *Mark 10:46–52* Blind Bartimaeus cried out—and Jesus stopped.

Reflection

Your cry matters. Desperation moves the heart of God. Bartimaeus refused to be silenced, and his persistence brought his miracle into manifestation.

Affirmation

My cry reaches Jesus, and He responds with healing.

Prayer

Jesus, hear my cry today. Strengthen my faith to call on You without fear or hesitation. Amen.

Call to Action

Spend 5 minutes in vocal prayer—crying out to Jesus for healing.

DAY 5 — *The Touch That Restores*

Scripture: *Mark 1:29–31* Jesus touched Peter’s mother-in-law, and the fever left immediately.

Reflection

One touch from Jesus changes everything. His healing is not partial—it restores strength, purpose, and function. When He heals, He also repositions you for service.

Affirmation

The touch of Jesus restores me fully—body, soul, and spirit.


Prayer

Lord, touch me in every place where weakness has settled. Restore my strength and renew my purpose. Amen.

Call to Action

Identify one area where you need restoration, not just relief.

DAY 6 — *Healing for the Hidden Places*

Scripture: *Psalm 147:3* “He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.”

Reflection

Some wounds are invisible but deeply felt. Jesus ministers to the hidden fractures of the heart. Nothing is too small, too old, or too painful for His healing.

Affirmation

Jesus heals the wounds I hide from others.

Prayer

Holy Spirit, shine Your light on the hidden places of my heart. Heal every unspoken wound. Amen.

Call to Action

Journal one hidden hurt you are ready to surrender to Jesus.

DAY 7 — *The Balm Still Heals Today*


Scripture: *Hebrews 13:8* “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.”

Reflection

The same Jesus who healed Bartimaeus and Peter’s mother-in-law is healing today. His power has not diminished. His compassion has not changed. His Balm still flows.

Affirmation


The healing virtue of Jesus is active in my life today.

Pray for someone else who needs healing—release the Balm you have received.




