SUMMARY

This message calls believers to radical trust in God and intentional movement with the Holy Spirit. Trust is not passive; it's active surrender. Guidance is not mystical; it's relational. Apostle Asia teaches that when we trust God fully and follow the Spirit faithfully, we walk in clarity, protection, divine timing, and supernatural provision.

KEY POINTS

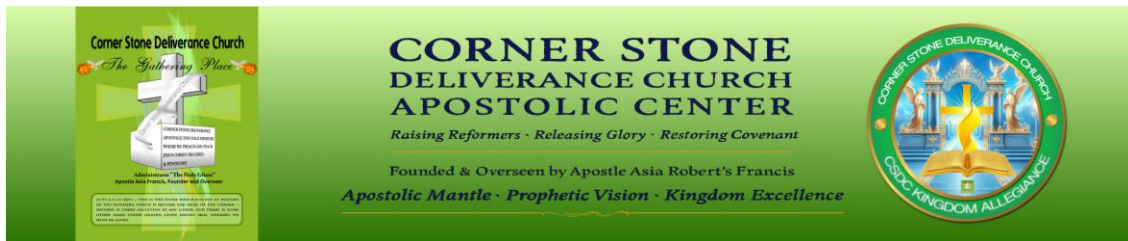
- Trust requires surrender of your own understanding.

AFFIRMATIONS

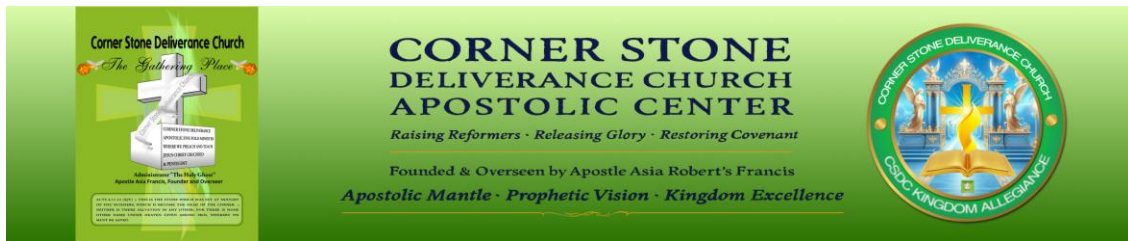
Declare these daily:

Reflect: Where have you resisted being led?

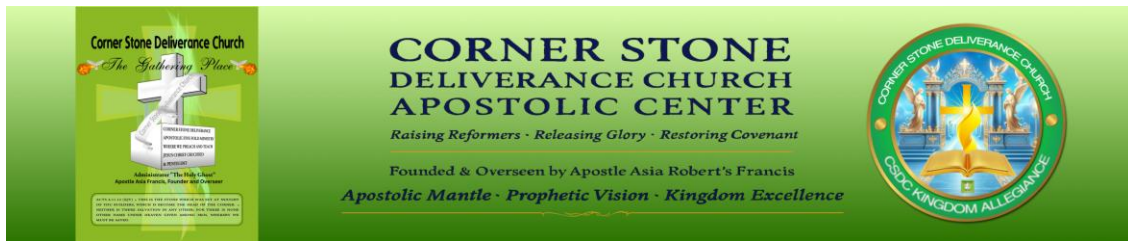
Prayer: “Father, I yield to Your Spirit as Your child.”

Day 4: Obedience in Motion

Reflect: What instruction have you delayed obeying?

Prayer: “Give me grace to obey quickly and completely.”

Reflect: What decisions need divine clarity?

Prayer: “Speak, Lord. I will walk in the way You show me.”

Day 6: Trusting Through Transition

Psalms 37:5

Reflect: What transition are you facing?

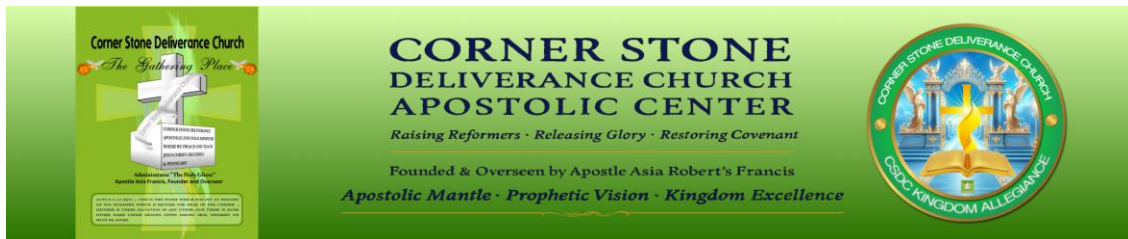
Prayer: “I commit my way to You, Lord. Lead me.”

Day 7: Supernatural Results of Trust

Jeremiah 17:7–8

Reflect: What fruit has trust produced in your life?

Prayer: “Make me like a tree planted by Your river.”

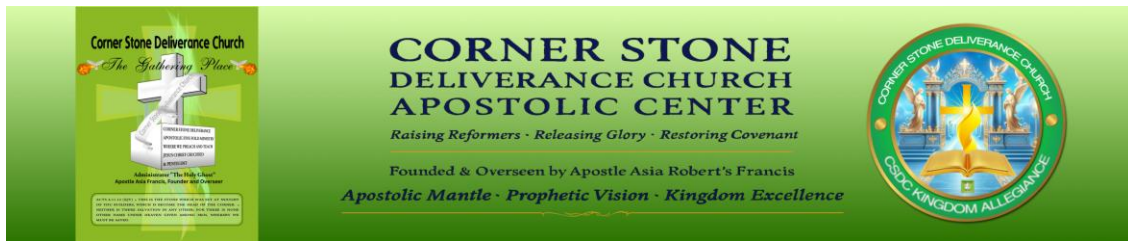
