2. The Cost of Discipleship

A. Deny Yourself — Luke 9:23

- Surrender your will
- Submit your desires
- Yield your plans
- Crucify the flesh

B. Take Up Your Cross Daily The cross = obedience unto death of:

- Pride
- Rebellion
- Old identity
- Old habits

C. Count the Cost — Luke 14:28 Discipleship requires:

- Time
- Discipline
- Sacrifice
- Accountability

- Consistency

A. Abides in the Word — John 8:31–32 B. Loves like Jesus — John 13:35 C. Bears Fruit — John 15:8 D. Follows the Holy Spirit

7-DAY DISCIPLESHIP DEVOTIONAL

Theme: The Cost and Call of True Discipleship

DAY 1 — “Follow Me”

Scripture: Matthew 4:19 **Reflection:** Jesus’ call is personal and direct. Discipleship begins with a yes. **Affirmation:** “I respond to the call of Jesus with a willing heart.” **Prayer:** Lord, awaken my desire to follow You fully. **Call to Action:** Write your personal “yes” to Jesus in one sentence.

DAY 2 — Denying Self

Scripture: Luke 9:23 **Reflection:** Self-denial is not loss—it is liberation. **Affirmation:** “My will bows to the will of God.” **Prayer:** Father, strip away every competing desire. **Call to Action:** Identify one area where your will must yield.

DAY 3 — Taking Up the Cross

Scripture: Galatians 2:20 **Reflection:** The cross is where the old you dies and the new you rises. **Affirmation:** “I am crucified with Christ; I live by His life.” **Prayer:** Jesus, teach me daily obedience. **Call to Action:** Surrender one habit or mindset that must die.

DAY 4 — Abiding in the Word

Scripture: John 8:31–32 **Reflection:** Discipleship requires consistency in the Word. **Affirmation:** “The Word shapes my identity and decisions.” **Prayer:** Holy Spirit, give me hunger for Scripture. **Call to Action:** Read one chapter of the Gospels today.

DAY 5 — Loving Like Jesus

Scripture: John 13:35 **Reflection:** Love is the evidence of discipleship. **Affirmation:** “I love with the heart of Christ.” **Prayer:** Lord, purify my motives and increase my compassion. **Call to Action:** Show intentional love to one person today.

DAY 6 — Bearing Fruit

Scripture: John 15:8 **Reflection:** Fruit is the visible proof of spiritual maturity. **Affirmation:** “My life produces fruit that glorifies God.” **Prayer:** Father, prune me so I may bear more fruit. **Call to Action:** Identify one fruit (character or action) to grow in.

DAY 7 — Walking in the Spirit

Scripture: Romans 8:14 **Reflection:** The Spirit leads disciples into maturity and purpose. **Affirmation:** “I am led by the Spirit in all things.” **Prayer:** Holy Spirit, guide my steps and decisions. **Call to Action:** Spend 10 minutes in silence listening for His direction.
