## CATCHING UP

#### **SUGGESTED TIME: 10-20 MINUTES**

As a family, we take time to check in on one another by catching up on life. What was good about your Thanksgiving? Is there anything difficult in your life we can be praying for?



### PAUSE

#### **SUGGESTED TIME: 1-2 MINUTES**

Before officially beginning group time, have someone lead the group through a pause prayer. Take a few deep breaths. Give everything and everyone to God. What do you need to let go of? Open your heart and mind to hear from Him and ask the Spirit to lead and guide everything that follows.

#### **SUGGESTED TIME: 10-20 MINUTES**

#### **SUGGESTED TIME: 20-40 MINUTES**

What is happening here through this "prophetic theatre"? Have someone recap the sermon. What might this kind of half-hearted obedience look like for us today? Joash didn't go all the way in destroying his arrows...is there an area of your life where you sense God inviting you to do something "extreme"? What will that look like? At the end of our series on Confluence, how is God inviting you to jump more fully into that "river" of fellowship with His Spirit?

## ENGAGE THE HEART

**SUGGESTED TIME: 20-40 MINUTES** 

Engage the Heart is creating space to look to Jesus, who was wholehearted in his obedience! He never backed down, never held back his trust, and went all the way to the cross to purchase full victory for us! Through the power of His sacrifice, the penalty for our sin has been ended. Through Him, we can put an end to our sin! As we walk in the light of honesty, we walk in the victory Jesus secured for us.
