**Malachi 3:6 (NLT)** *I am the Lord, and I do not change....*

**Psalms 119:89 (NLT)** *Your eternal word, O Lord, stands firm in heaven.*

**Isaiah 26:4 (NLT)** *Trust in the Lord always, for the Lord God is the eternal Rock.*

**James 1:17 (NLT)** *Whatever is good and perfect is a gift coming down to us from God our Father... He never changes or casts a shifting shadow.*

### Psalm 28:7 (NLT)

*The LORD is my strength and shield. I trust him with all my heart. He helps me, and my heart is filled with joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving.*

**Psalm 40:8 (NLT)**

*I take joy in doing your will, my God, for your instructions are written on my heart.”*

**Jeremiah 15:16 (NLT)**

*When I discovered your words, I devoured them. They are my joy and my heart’s delight, for I bear your name, O LORD God of Heaven’s Armies.*

**Romans 14:17 (NLT)**

*For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but living a life of goodness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.*

**Nehemiah 8:12 (NLT)**

*Many sacrifices were offered on that joyous day, for God had given the people cause for great joy. The women and children also participated in the celebration, and the joy of the people of Jerusalem could be heard far away.*

**Psalm 45:7 (NLT)**

*You love justice and hate evil. Therefore God, your God, has anointed you, pouring out the oil of joy on you more than on anyone else.*

**Psalm 97:11 (NLT)**

*Light shines on the godly, and joy on those whose hearts are right.*

**Be generous**

**Philemon 7 (NLT)**

*Your love has given me much joy and comfort, my brother, for your kindness has often refreshed the hearts of God’s people.*

**Learn to \_\_\_\_\_ God**

**Psalm 43:4 (NLT)**

*There I will go to the altar of God, to God—the source of all my joy. I will praise you with my harp, O God, my God!*

**Psalm 68:3 (NLT)**

*But let the godly rejoice. Let them be glad in God’s presence. Let them be filled with joy.*
