**New Testament**-Greek word "oikodomea" means to be a house builder, construct, confirm, embolden, build up, edify. It is related to structure, architecture and confirmation.

## 2. God gives Specific instructions for Building

Genesis 6:14-16 (NIV)

So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. This is how you are to build it: The ark is to be 450 feet long. 75 feet wide and high. Make a roof for it and finish the ark to within 18 inches of the top. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks."

Hebrews 8:5 (NIV)

They serve a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven, This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."
