We do understand that because the church has not always been able to function at the level of its calling, some good people have established other organisations that care for people and provide teaching for Christians. But we believe that as God builds His church, these places will give way to the local church. Other Christian organisations are not the plan of God, although they do good work, it is not His plan.
