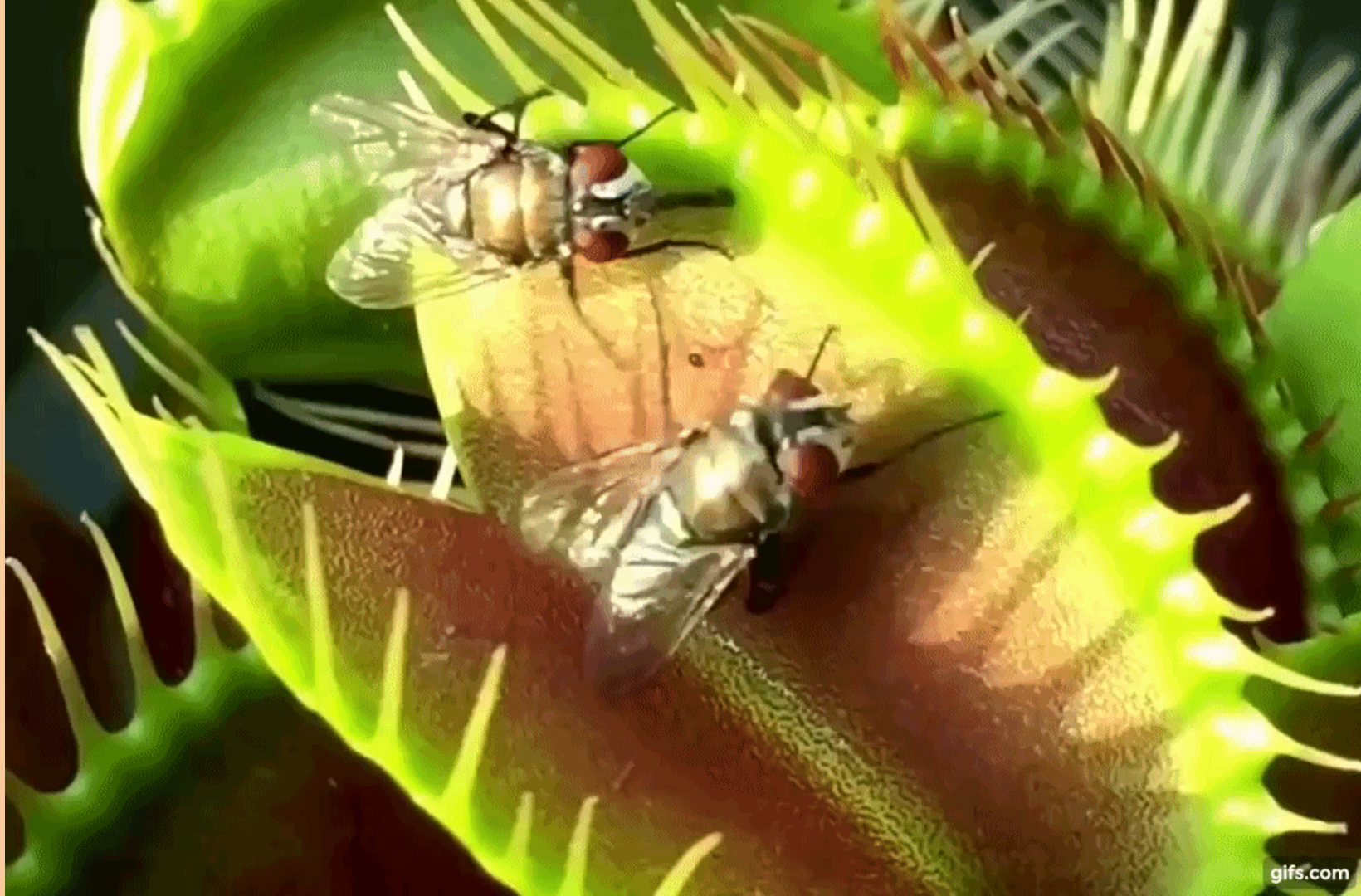


JEREMIAH





Jeremiah 50:1-2 The word that the LORD spoke concerning Babylon, concerning the land of the Chaldeans, by Jeremiah the prophet:

2“Declare among the nations and proclaim, set up a banner and proclaim, conceal it not, and say: Babylon is taken, Bel is put to shame, Merodach is dismayed. Her images are put to shame, her idols are dismayed.’



from heaven saying,


“Come out of her, my people,

Revelation 18:10


They will stand far off, in fear of her torment, and say,
