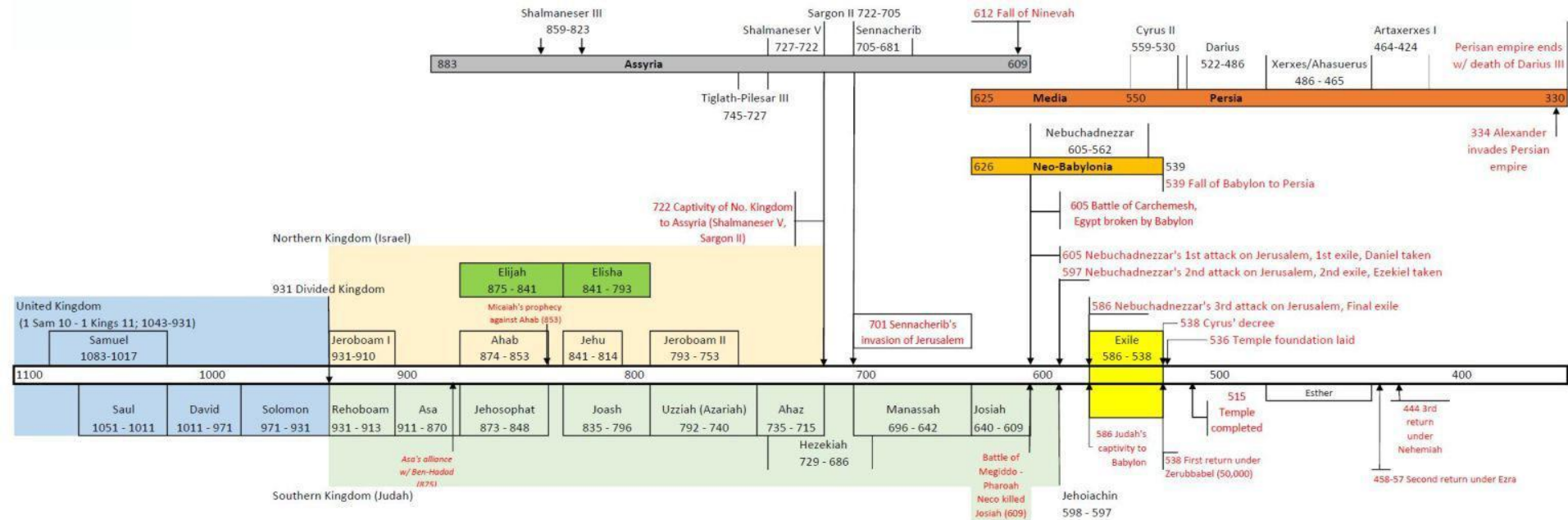

I will accomplish all my purpose,'

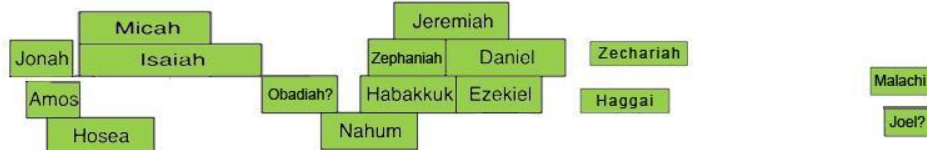
11 calling a bird of prey from the east, the
