How **Strongly** does the Bible say that **Immediate**Baptism in Water is **Essential**?

Mt. 10:33 But whoever **denies Me** before **men**, **him** I will **also deny before My Father** who is in heaven.

The Bible is very strong and clear that Baptism in Water is the **FIRST** step of **Obedience** for **every** Christian. The Bible also makes it clear that this act of being **Publicly Immersed** in Water is an **Identification** with **Christ** in his death and resurrection.

When we are **Baptized** in **Water**, we let the **entire world** know that we now **Belong** to **Jesus**!

In extremist Muslim societies, you can "Call Yourself" a Christian and receive no repercussions. However the minute you get Baptized in Water, your life is in great danger, and you may be killed for your faith.

Muslims are very aware that calling yourself a "Christian" has no weight or value unless you are willing to publicly identify with Jesus in his death and resurrection through Baptism in Water.

Please notice the **IMMEDIATE response** to **Salvation** in **EVERY Bible verse** that mentions **Baptism** in **Water**.

Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "**Repent** and be **baptized**, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:41 Those who accepted his message were **baptized**, and about three thousand were added to their number.

Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip as he preached the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized** both men and women.

Acts 8: 36-37 As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. Why shouldn't I be baptized? "Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." The eunuch answered, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.".

Acts 9:18 Something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he could see again. He got up and was **baptized**.

Acts 16:15 When she and the members of her household were baptized, she invited us to her home.

Acts 16:33 the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then **immediately** he and all his family were **baptized**.

Acts 18:8 Many of the Corinthians who heard him **believed and were baptized.**

Acts 19:5 On hearing this they were **baptized** in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 22:16 And now what are you waiting for? **Get up, be** baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name.

Why is it important to be **Immersed** in Water?

Before you go too far in this booklet, may I ask if you have read the booklet titled:

"Will Half-way Christians go to Hell?"

That booklet gives great clarity on the covenant of salvation. One of the main reasons why there are so **many** that **claim** to be Christians but will **NOT** be in **heaven** is because they do **NOT understand** the subject of us **DYING** with Christ.

When I go **UNDER** that water, I am **DYING** to ever again being in control or ruling my own life.

When I come up **OUT** of that water, I am telling the world that I am a **NEW CREATION** resurrected with Christ.

The word "*Baptism*" in the **original Greek language** of the New Testament literally means to **immerse**.

Col. 2:12 having been **buried** with **him** in **baptism** and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead.

Rom. 6:3-4 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

If I was **baptized** as an **infant**, do I **need** to be baptized **again**?

Baptizing infants was a practice that originated from the practice of **dedicating** babies to the Lord. This is what Hannah did with her baby son Samuel in I Samuel 1. Dedicating a baby to the Lord as an infant is a **beautiful** and **meaningful** ceremony. It is a time of **asking** the **Lord** to guide and **protect** this child and to help the parents bring this child to Christ.

However, it is very important for each person to make a **personal decision** to be water baptized as a declaration to the world that they have **personally received** Jesus as their Savior. This is why the scriptures indicate that it was **AFTER** a decision for Christ that the person was Water Baptized.

Mt. 28:19 Therefore go and **make disciples** of all nations, **baptizing** them

in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

Lk. 3:3 He went into all the country around the Jordan, preaching a **baptism** of **repentance** for the forgiveness of

Acts 10:47 Then Peter said, "Can anyone keep these people from being baptized with water?

They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have."

- Gal. 3:27 for all of you who were **baptized into Christ** have **clothed yourselves with Christ**.
- I Pt. 3:2 this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God.

 It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ

Other Questions!

i. If I have re-dedicated my life, should I get RE-Baptized?

Generally, yes! There are many people who move from a state of being unsure to very sure that they are ready to follow Christ, and they declare this through being re-baptized.

ii. How **old** does a **child** have to be to be Water Baptized?

The child must be old enough to understand that: they are a sinner, that Christ died for their sins, and that by receiving Jesus free gift of eternal life they are going to heaven. For some children this happens as young as 4-5 years old. Whenever you are unsure, it helps greatly to go carefully and thoroughly through this study with your child.

"Will Half-way Christians go to Hell?"

This study breaks down the covenant of salvation so clearly that a child can fully grasp the concept.

iii. How do I get Water Baptized at this church?

All that is necessary is to let our WELCOME STAFF know that you are ready to be water baptized.

They will walk you through all the details and serve you cheerfully through the entire process. They will answer all your questions, schedule with you and confirm the date. They will meet with you upstairs and show you the changing room, the extra towels and the nice warm water baptismal.
