

• <sup>3</sup> The elders of Jabesh said to him, "Give us seven days so we can send messengers throughout Israel; if no one comes to rescue us, we will surrender to you."

• 1 Samuel 11:6 "When Saul heard their words, the Spirit of God came upon him in power, and he burned with anger."






#### V. GENEROSITY TOWARDS SAUL'S OPPONENTS (V.12-13)

- 12 The people then said to Samuel, "Who was it that asked, 'Shall Saul reign over us?' Turn these men over to us so that we may put them to death."
- <sup>13</sup> But Saul said, "No one will be put to death today, for this day the LORD has rescued Israel."




## VI. SAMUEL REAFFIRMS SAUL'S KINGSHIP (V. 14-15)

• <sup>14</sup> Then Samuel said to the people, "Come, let us go to Gilgal and there renew the kingship." <sup>15</sup> So all the people went to Gilgal and made Saul king in the presence of the LORD. There they sacrificed fellowship offerings before the LORD, and Saul and all the Israelites held a great celebration.




# **RIGHTEOUS ANGER**
