
<u>II Kings 13:14-19</u> Now Elisha had been suffering from the illness from which he died. Jehoash king of Israel went down to see him and wept over him. "My father!" he cried. "The chariots and horsemen of Israel!"

- 1. 15 Elisha said, "Get a bow and some arrows," and he did so.
- 2. 16"Take the bow in your hands," he said to the king of Israel.
- When he had taken it, Elisha PUT his HANDS on the king's hands.
- 4. 17"Open the east window," he said, and he opened it.
- 5. "Shoot!" Elisha said, and he shot.
- 6. "The Lord's arrow of victory, the arrow of victory over Aram!" Elisha declared.
- 7. "You will completely destroy the Arameans at Aphek."

<sup>18</sup> Then he said, "Take the arrows," and the king took them. Elisha told him, "Strike the ground." He struck it three times and stopped. <sup>19</sup> The man of God was **ANGRY** with him and said, "You **SHOULD** have struck the ground FIVE or SIX times; then you would have defeated Aram and completely destroyed it. But now you will defeat it only three times."



<u>II Kings 13:20-21</u> Elisha died and was **buried**. Now Moabite raiders used to enter the country every spring. <sup>21</sup> Once while some Israelites were burying a man, suddenly they saw a band of raiders; so they threw the **man's body** into **Elisha's tomb**. When the **body touched Elisha's bones**, the man came to **life** and stood up on his **feet**.
