### THE DEFINITION OF AN ADULT

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 4:15 – 17 – Paul Defines

- He says to the Corinthians, "...in Christ Jesus, I became your **father**."
- He goes on from there and says, "I urge you to \_\_\_\_\_ me."
- He defines fatherhood as **modeling**.
- The attitudes that **you** live will be **imparted** to your children.

The Definition of an Adult:

- The opposite of resisting responsibility is not to resist it but to seek it.
- The ultimate goal is to know Him.

- You reproduce who you are.
- If you're a man of God, you say "Son answering your parents is a piece of cake compared to answering to God."
- When you seek counsel, you ought to seek counsel from those who \_\_\_\_\_ you the most, are the most \_\_\_\_\_ to you, and who know you the \_\_\_\_\_.

This is the atom bomb of power in raising kids.

**Ages 6 – 18 : Build Friendship**

### 4 Fantastic Fruits of Seeking Your Teen's and Pre-Teen's Advice

**F** \_\_\_\_\_ - if you want your kids to respect you, this is the greatest gift you could ever give them.

**I** \_\_\_\_\_ - lecturing as instruction ceases to be effective at \_\_\_\_\_ years old. God began to prepare them for adulthood, and no adult likes to be lectured. God wants you to begin mixing instruction with seeking advice. (Examples).

**L** \_\_\_\_\_ - from your child's perspective, if you seek their advice than Jesus is your Lord. If you don't, He's not your Lord.

**L** \_\_\_\_\_ - if you can bring your family together, you are ready to be an executive in any company. A leader, when he seeks advice, never points out the negative in that advice as his first response.

### Two Conclusions

# 1 – **The Psalm 1 Warning** - you are warned to never seek counsel from \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ people.

- The first five years is when you establish discipline.
- How to know if you've done well establishing discipline -- Tone of voice and Repeated commands.
- You then enter into the time when you start building a friendship.
- At 6 – 10 years old it is a sweet thing to seek your pre-teen's advice.
- You can't do that if you skip stage 1 (Examples).

# 2 – **A Word to Teenagers** – how to melt my parents (or how to be given great freedom by my parents). Two things:

- Take \_\_\_\_\_ for your actions.
- Seek your parent's \_\_\_\_\_. Even if your parents are children, you be an adult.
