

⁷ He also said to him, “I am the LORD, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to **take possession** of it.” *What did Abram think God meant by this? What had Abram just finished doing a few days before?*

⁸ But Abram said, “O Sovereign LORD, how **can I know** that I will **gain possession** of it?” *What was Abram asking in this question. Write in your Bibles →*

⁹ So the LORD said to him, *5 animals used in sacrifices in the law of Moses.* “Bring me a heifer, *Numbers 19* the heifer made the priests clean and prepared to work the Law. The covenant of Abraham prepared the way for the second covenant of the law *a goat Matthew 25:31-34* and a ram, *Male Sheep Gen. 22* each three years old, along with a dove *Holy Spirit Luke 4* and a young pigeon.” *GO & TELL THEM Mt. 28*

¹⁰ Abram brought all these to him, **cut them in two** *Root word of covenant means to CUT / Hard Bloody work* and arranged the halves opposite each other; the birds, however, he did not cut in half. ¹¹ Then birds of prey came down on the carcasses, but Abram drove them away. *When you seek to covenant with the Lord, you will have to fight off Birds of Prey – Mt. 13 seed on hard ground – birds ate.*

¹² As the sun was setting, Abram fell into a deep sleep, *Slain in the Spirit – Daniel 10:9* and a thick and dreadful darkness came over him. *Fear of the Lord* ¹³ Then the LORD said to him, *7 prophecies* “Know for certain that your ^{1.} **descendants** will be **strangers** in a **country not** their **own**, and ^{2.} they will be **enslaved** and **mistreated** ^{3.} four hundred years. ¹⁴ But ^{4.} I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and ^{5.} afterward they will come out with great possessions. ¹⁵ ^{6.} You, however, will go to your fathers in peace and be buried at a good old age. ¹⁶ ^{7.} In the **fourth generation** your descendants will come back here, for the sin of the Amorites has not yet reached its full measure.” *Sin of the earth is FULL – Lord will return Who read and feared these words – Isaac, Jacob, Jacob's sons as they went into Egypt.*

¹⁷ When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, a smoking firepot *OVEN /Furnace* with a blazing torch appeared *When you suffer – furnace – God will be WITH you - blazing Torch* and passed between the pieces. ¹⁸ On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram and said, “To your descendants I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the Euphrates— ¹⁹ the land of the Kenites, Kenizzites, Kadmonites, ²⁰ Hittites, Perizzites, Rephaites, ²¹ Amorites, Canaanites, Gergashites and Jebusites.”
