I Samuel 7- 8 2/23-24/19

¹⁶He used to go annually on circuit to <u>Bethel</u> and <u>Gilgal</u> and <u>Mizpah</u>, and he judged Israel in all these places. ¹⁷Then his return was to <u>Ramah</u>, for his house was there, and there he judged Israel; and he built there an altar to the LORD.

ISam. 8 When Samuel grew old, he APPOINTED his sons as Israel's leaders. 2 The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba. 3 But his sons did not follow his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice. 4 So all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah. 5 They said to him, "You are old, and your sons do not follow your ways; now appoint a king to lead us, such as all the other nations have."

<u>I Sam. 12:2-4</u> TLB I have **selected him ahead of my own sons** and now I stand here, an **old, gray**-haired man who has been in public service from the time he was a **lad**. ³ Now tell me as I stand before the Lord and before his anointed king—**whose ox or donkey have I stolen**? Have I **ever defrauded** you? Have I ever oppressed you? Have I **ever taken a bribe**? Tell me and I will make right whatever I have done wrong." ⁴ "No," they replied, "you have never defrauded or oppressed us in any way and you have never taken even one single bribe."

- > I Sam. 9:25 Samuel took Saul up to the porch on the ROOF and TALKED with him there.
- ➤ I Sam. 10:1 Then Samuel took a flask of olive oil and poured it on Saul's head and **KISSED** him, saying, "**Has not the Lord anointed you ruler** over his inheritance?
- I Sam. 15:35 Until the day Samuel died, he did not go to see Saul again, though Samuel MOURNED for him.
- > I Sam. 16:1 The LORD said to Samuel, "How long will you MOURN for Saul, since I have rejected him as king over Israel?

<u>I Sam. 19:20</u> so he sent men to capture him. But when they saw a **group of prophets prophesying, with Samuel standing there as their leader**, the Spirit of God came on Saul's men, and they also prophesied.
