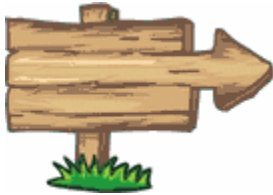

Imp. Note: Study Hebrews 11:1, 6

“**Substance**” **5287 *hupostasis***: from a compound of 5259 and 2476; a setting under (support), i.e. (figuratively) concretely, essence, or abstractly, assurance (objectively or subjectively):--confidence, confident, person, substance.

“**Evidence**” **1651 *elegcho***: to convict, refute, confute a) generally with a suggestion of shame of the person convicted b) by conviction to bring to the light, to expose 2) to find fault with, correct a) by word 1) to reprehend severely, chide, admonish, reprove 2) to call to account, show one his fault, demand an explanation b) by deed 1) to chasten, to punish
