5. John 3:29-30. Can you name a time recently when you were genuinely happy for someone else? What was that like?
6. What can you do to help train yourself to rejoice in Christ more?
7. Read John 3:31-36. What are some practical, everyday ways we can call attention to Christ (and how great He is) and not to ourselves?
8. What is a main takeaway from this series so far for you? How can this group pray for you so you can apply it?
