- 3. Why did Jesus sit down at the well? What does this say about Him?
- 4. Samaritans were hated by the Jews for simply being Samaritans. What is an example of a modern-day Samaritan?
- 5. What groups of people do you find yourself feeling uncomfortable around?
- 6. How might your response to others be different when you have hurt and pain in your past, as the Samaritan woman did?
- 7. What are some ways that people try to fill the emptiness in their lives apart from Jesus' Living Water? How does Jesus satisfy those needs?
- 8. How do true worshipers worship according to Jesus? How can we apply this today?
- 9. As we share Jesus with others, what lessons from this passage should we keep in mind?
