3. Why did Jesus sit down at the well? What does this say about Him?
4. Samaritans were hated by the Jews for simply being Samaritans. What is an example of a modern-day Samaritan?
5. What groups of people do you find yourself feeling uncomfortable around?
6. How might your response to others be different when you have hurt and pain in your past, as the Samaritan woman did?
7. What are some ways that people try to fill the emptiness in their lives apart from Jesus' Living Water? How does Jesus satisfy those needs?
8. How do true worshipers worship according to Jesus? How can we apply this today?
9. As we share Jesus with others, what lessons from this passage should we keep in mind?
