FOCAL PASSAGE

I John 1:5-10

⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. ⁶ If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth. ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. ⁸ If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

I John 2:1-6

¹ My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. ² He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. ³ We know that we have come to know Him if we keep His commands. ⁴ Whoever says, "I know Him," but does not do what He commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. ⁵ But if anyone obeys His word, love for God is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in Him: ⁶ Whoever claims to live in Him must live as Jesus did.

THREE WAYS TO DEAL WITH OUR SINS:

WE CAN TRY TO COVER OUR SINS

I John 1:5

⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

1. CONSIDER THE PROCESS OF SALVATION

—When we were saved, God called us out of darkness into His light.

I Peter 2:9

- ⁹ But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
- —We become children of light.

I Thessalonians 5:5

- ⁵ You are all children of the light and children of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness.
- —Those who do wrong (sin) hate light.

¹⁹ This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. ²⁰ Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed. ²¹ But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God.

- —If we are walking in the light, the darkness has to go.
- —If we are holding to sin, then light goes.

2. HOW DO CHRISTIANS TRY TO COVER THEIR SINS?

- —There are a number of expressions but all point to on method by telling lies!
- A. First, we tell lies to <u>others</u>.
- B. We begin to lie to <u>ourselves</u>.
- C. Attempt to lie to <u>God</u>.
- —When we look at the human heart through the Holy Spirit's inspiration, we see how devastating and corrupt the heart is.

Believers lie about . . .

—Their FELLOWSHIP: I John 1:6

- ⁶ If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth.
- —About our NATURE: I John 1:8
- ⁸ If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.
- —And about our ACTIONS: I John 1:10
- ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.
- —Sin has a deadly way of spreading, doesn't it?

C HAS TWO SIDES TO IT
—The two sides of cleansing are the judicial and personal sides.
—The blood of Jesus Christ, shed on the cross, delivers us from the guilt of sin and gives us a right standing (justification) before God.
—God is able to forgive because Jesus' death has satisfied God's Holy Law.
—God is also interested in cleansing a sinner inwardly.
—David prayed, "Create in me a clean heart, O God." Psalm 51:10
—When our confession is sincere, God does a cleansing work in our heart by His Spirit and through His Word.
I John 1:9 ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
John 15:3 ³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.
—When should we confess our sin? Immediately when we discover it!
Proverbs 28:13 13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
—By walking in the light, we are able to see the "dirt" in our lives and deal with it immediately.
This leads to a third way to deal with sins: We can try to cover them, we can confess them, or

—How is sin battling for control of your life?
—How are you allowing yourself to believe in a lie?
—How are you attempting to convince others you are okay spiritually?
—What have you allowed yourself to see that is demanding the long look?
—How has God indicated to you to deal with sin in your life?
—Will you take the first step by taking ownership of your own sin?
