## January 23- February 3rd



7 PPC members (Phil Black, Pamela Conley, Brent & Anna Grimes, Chris Hill, Danielle Price and Bonnie Stiffler) are taking medical supplies and support to clinics in different villages in the Oti region of Ghana. Due to the remoteness of the villages, this endeavor is both difficult and expensive.

### So why do we go?

Simply put, because the *need* and the *impact* are so great.

- Villagers must travel hours to see a doctor. With the mission team, serious problems can be addressed. Early detection can mitigate future medical conditions.
- A clinic in their village means 500 people can see a doctor in one day. We can address real health issues and show God's love.
- Perhaps more importantly, our clinics in conjunction with the on-going effort to reach the Chala and Kotokoli, help open hearts to the Gospel.

Please pray for the *eternal* impact from the clinics we provide and especially for the gospel to penetrate the hearts of the Kotokoli people.

#### **Tuesday, January 23rd      Leave Dayton**

### **Thursday, February 1st Depart Nkwanta for Accra.**
