- Paul asks his people to pray for him (v. 1-2)
- Paul assures his people of God's work in their lives (v. 3-4)
- Paul pronounces a blessing on his people (v. 5)

DISCUSSION (INTERPRETATION):

- 1. Why do you think he asks for prayers for protection from wicked men? Self-protection is surely involved, but what do you think is his primary motive in this request?
- 2. What does it mean for God to "establish" His people? (See how different English Bibles render that verb.) What is God doing when He "establishes" us?
