

The Book of Deuteronomy is a collection of sermons Moses delivered to the people of God just before they entered the Land promised to their fathers. (This [Bible Project's video on Deuteronomy](#) explains its overall structure and message.) In our text, [Deut 18:15-18](#), Moses promises that God will raise up a prophet to guide His people. That prophecy was fulfilled in a smaller sense in the men God used over the centuries to speak His Word to His people, but it was fulfilled in its ultimate sense in Christ.
