Title: Generous hearted living

Bible Reference: Galatians 6

Overview

Is true freedom really achievable? Can we live free, and stay free from addictions, habits, and temptations? As we conclude this series, Paul answers the questions with a resounding yes - and draws our attention to one thing: the cross of Jesus. Read Galatians 6

Paul gloried in the cross because he knew:

- 1. The Person of the cross.** The God who humbled himself, taking on human form (Phil 2: 5-8) and dying in our place. He can relate to us, and we to him - he can sympathise with us. It's at the cross that we begin a relationship with Jesus. Have you met him?
- 2. The Power of the cross.** It exposes us for what we really are - guilty. But at the same time it reveals God's incredible love towards us, that Jesus would pay the awful penalty for us. Because of the cross, our worth does not come from status, power, possessions, other people's affections - it comes from God's opinion of us, overflowing in love at the cross. Gal 6:15 through the cross we're a new creation, old creation addictions no longer have any hold on us.
- 3. The Purpose of the cross.** Hebrews 12:2 Jesus endured the cross for the joy set before him. Through it God is restoring selfish humanity to him. Start of Gal 6 - see the way believers are to care for one another, the cross transforms our hearts to live generously, following Jesus' example and sacrificially loving others. His new creation is a glimpse of Heaven, and witness to the world.

Questions

1. Do you believe it is possible to live free from a given pattern of sin, addiction, thought patterns? Have you decided that it is possible for some, but not for you?
2. What do you boast in? Your job, your achievements, your family, your heritage? What would it look like to boast only in the cross?
3. Are the marks of Jesus (Gal 6:17) on your life? The marks of costly giving to serve the Lord. Are they on your body - persecution, suffering, ridicule or loss of relationship for the sake of Jesus? Are they on your calendar - time carved out to pursue his kingdom rather than your own ends? Are they on your bank account - money set aside for his kingdom?

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
