Title: From Terrorist to Evangelist

Bible Reference: Galations 1:11-24

Overview

Paul is angry that these so-called Christians are abandoning the radical truth of the Gospel, and in so doing, forfeiting their true freedom as followers of Jesus. So he demonstrates the genuineness of 'his' Gospel by giving his testimony – recounting the radical change that happened in his life. We can see a pattern in his story that should be part of every genuine experience of the Gospel.

Main points

- The Gospel is Powerful. It is truth plus experience.
- The Gospel is Personal. It means much to us individually, even when we're alone
- The Gospel Produces Change. Others should begin to see the difference!
- The Gospel involves a Personal Encounter with Jesus

Questions

- Can you remember your experience of becoming a Christian?
 - Share your stories together!
- Paul used his own story to point people to Christ. Do you feel confident to use yours?
- Condemnation (not feeling good enough etc) is common among Christians, but shouldn't be!
 - Are you aware **daily**, that your acceptance to God is all of grace or do you feel it must be earned?
- Our relationship with Jesus, like every relationship, needs to grow.
 - What strategies can we use to help us grow in our relationship with Jesus?
