Old Testament Prophetic Signs

Isaiah

- 9:6-7
- **40:3-5**

Malachi

4:5-6

- Luke likely noted that Zechariah & Elizabeth were righteous and not cursed
- v7 KJV "well stricken in years"
- In this time est. 20,000 priests, 24 Divisions, each division served 2 weeks
 - Chosen by lot...not super spiritual
 - Once in a lifetime honor for Zechariah
- People praying & waiting for the priestly blessing

- John= "Jehovah has show grace"
 - Note: "Great before the Lord"
 - Note: Quote Malachi Zechariah knew it
 - Jesus Matt. 11:14 He is the "Elijah to come"
- Zechariah's unbelief kept him from seeing and understanding
- Discipline = take away his voice & then reduced to only communicating with signs

- People & Elizabeth recognized the signs and believed
- Elizabeth did not hide out in disbelief
- Birth quite a bit different...everyone involved!
- v62 almost makes it seem like Zachariah is deaf as well
- Interesting Zachariah's first words...a 'Whoa' moment!
- Speaks of Messiah more than his son!

Signs of Messiah

- 1) God's Word
- 2) Meeting an angel from God
- 3) Prayer is Heard
 - a. For a Child
 - b. For Messiah
- 4) Joy/Gladness/Rejoicing
- 5) Move/Work of the Holy Spirit
 - a. John was special/unique by the HS
- 6) John Himself (voice in the wild...)

Signs of Messiah

- 7) Message of Good News
- 8) Getting Pregnant in old age
- 9) Child Birth
- 10) When Zechariah spoke Blessed God
- 11)Sold out & believed in Messiah Spoke of Him more than his own son

Questions for us:

- o What about God's Word:
 - Is the Lord trying to show you or speak?
 - Are you putting yourself in a place to hear from him, see the signs
- o Is God hearing from you in prayer?
- Owner of the Working or working or birthing something new?

Questions for us:

- O Are you being a sign?
- o Are you calling people to turn?
- o Am I sharing Good News or Bad News?
- O Are you blessing & believe in God?
- O Am I sold out and looking for Messiah?
