Noteworthy:

- Be Careful what you ask for -Genesis 30:1
- + Gen. 49:3-4
- Interesting Christ came through Judah

Genesis Review:

- 9:25 Ham cursed
- 10:6-7, 15-20 Descendants of Ham
- 25:23 Prophecy about Jacob & Esau
- 25:27-34 Esau despises birthright

Genesis 35:1-14

Esau's Wives:

- 26:34-35 First two wives = source of grief for Isaac & Rebekah
- 28:6-9 Spitefully marries his cousin
- Notice the names of his wives are different

Esau's Wives:

- Judith "Jewish, praiseworthy" = Adah
 - See Genesis 4:23
- Basemath "Fragrance" =
 Oholibamah "My Tent is a High Place"
 - See v.14 & 24-29
- Mahalath "sickness" = Basemath

Noteworthy:

- v.12 & 16 Amalek = Amalekites
 - Ex. 17:14 blot out their memory
 - 1 Sam. 15 Saul disobeys
- Ex. 23:23 all Canaanites driven out
 - Deut. 20:16-18 completely destroyed

Noteworthy:

- v.31 "before any Israelite king"
 - 1 Samuel 8 Israel asks for a king
- Esau had his kids in the promise land and then left
- Jacob had his kids outside of the promise land and settled down there

Obadiah

Definition for Culture:

- The <u>customary beliefs</u>, <u>social forms</u> and material traits of a racial religious, or social group
- The characteristic <u>features of everyday</u> <u>existence</u> (such as diversions or a way of life) shared by people in a place or time

Definition for Culture:

- Set of <u>shared attitudes</u>, <u>values</u>, <u>goals</u>, <u>and practices</u> that characterize an institution or organization
- The intergrated pattern of human knowledge, belief, and behavior that depends upon the capacity for learning and transmitting knowledge to succeeding generations

Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, etc:

- Baal had temple prostitutes
- Molech threw babies on his hands
- Dagon fish god 1 Sam. 5
- Asherah fertility god = wood poles
