Chap. 25 Reminders:

- Isaac & Rebekah have twins
- v.23 God tells Rebekah Two nations in her, Older will serve the younger
- Esau Hairy, Man of the open country
- Jacob Quiet, among the tents
- Vv.28 Isaac loved Esau, Bekah loved Jacob

Favoritism & Inconsistancy

- Breeds Competition
- Breaks Communication
- Begs Manipulation
- Births Deception
- Brings Seperation

Ultimately: Bummers rather than Blessings

God deals with different children differently, but fairly according to knowledge and truth.

These events speak of: 1. God's Sovereignty

- "possessing supreme or ultimate power"
- Romans 9:10-16
- God knows what he is doing, he has a plan, and doesn't need our figuring it out...

God's sovereignty can be misunderstood as favoritism or inconsistancy.

These events speak of:

2. God's Promises

- Genesis 15:1-6, 21:12, 25:21-23
- His Word = His-story, truth, result is proof

3. God's Grace

 Unearned, unmerited, undeserved favor from God = chapter 28 "For God's gifts and his call are irrevocable."
