NOTES: Chapter 20

- * The fascinating thing about chapter 20 is that Israel is already at the end of their 40 years of wandering in the desert.
 - Not much is said about those 40 years because it was wasted time!
 - How do we know? Num. 33:37-39
 - Deut. 2:7 - they did not lack anything!
- * Not the first time that God provided water from a rock - Exodus 17:1-7

* 2 Cor. 5:16-21

- The Word says over & over = New Covenant - Heb. 7-8
- We can't get stuck in the 'we've always done it this way' mentality
- Jesus told Jewish leadership - can't put 'new wine into old wineskins'

* We can't assume what God is going to do

NOTES: Chapter 20

- * **Can't just go through the motions - must hear & DO the Word**
 - **Faith & Trust which leads to obedience - even if God is doing it different this time**
 - **Time doesn't necessarily make a person wiser, smarter or more mature**

NOTES: Chapter 20

- * **We must have an 'It is Finished' attitude**
 - **Heb. 9:22-28 - speak to the rock**
 - **Heb. 10:19-31 - don't keep doing the same things**
 - **We stop blaming others - Deut. 1:37**
 - **Edomites - James 3:13-18**
- * **The old man/woman must die - Rom. 6**

NOTES: Chapter 20

- * **WE can do nothing, Christ can do anything!**
 - I need stop trying to accomplish these changes myself or for someone else!
 - Definition of insanity = keep doing the same thing over and over again expecting different results
 - Surrender to him, trusting him in the desert...promise land was only a few miles away!
