Sanctification:

Separation to God for His
purpose & will

**(More than being different
for difference sake!)**

How do we know God is Sanctifying:

1. **Discontent** in the world/flesh
2. **Difference** from the world/flesh
3. **Division** with the world/flesh
4. **Disconnect** from the world/flesh
